For **English** this week, Can you please show your child the following video - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1gGYNBwTnAI> . Please encourage your child to cut out the structural parts (roof, window, door) of the house and glue them onto the house template sheet (please use the house sheet with the date for this week on it). For tomorrow lesson, watch the video again and encourage your child to label the parts of the house – roof, wall, floor, window and door (on the same sheet).

For **Maths** find two similar object of different sizes, ie book, teddy bottle etc, put them next to each other and ask your child to give you the big/small one, ask them how they know it is the big one? For the first lesson encourage your child to order 3 house by size, they should do this activity twice by cutting out the house and sticking them on to the paper in a line in size order. For tomorrow lesson do the same activity but ordering the 5 house instead of 3. After that can they find the correct house on the sheet to match other.

The following are a list of activities that you could do for **PE** – go on a bike/scooter ride while taking the dog/going for a walk. Watch Joe wicks on Your tube. Watch cosmic kids – yoga video on you tube, play a few games on just dance or watch it on you tube – enjoy!

Science – You extra lesson, please show your child the powerpoint emailed out. Encourage them to draw a picture of different thing which use a power source of electricity in each room on the sheet.

Cooking – This term we are focusing on cutting and spreading different textures, Encourage your child to make a sandwich, using butter and a spreadable fill, ie soft cheese, chocolate spread, jam etc. – Take a picture.
