This initiative appears to be working well for families and so a quick reminder here about how you can order school uniform on line. Follow the link:

Snapchat and Snap Maps

The introduction of the location based map on the app Snapchat has caused a lot of concern. The Snap Map shows a user's Bitmoji (their cartoon avatar), on a map and then you can zoom in to see their exact location. This clearly has implications for children and vulnerable young people.

Childnet have published information about Snap Maps, top tips on keeping safe and instructions on how to change the settings to ensure any risk is minimised. The best tip is to use ghost mode which means that the individual themselves is the only person who can see the location.
