Due to the current pandemic it is paramount that the areas which have been used are cleaned down after lessons have finished. The Facilities Team will clean down all areas which have been used and allow them to air dry between lessons.

On recommendation from the PWTAG Technical note 46 our chemical levels have had to be adjusted, the new recommended chemical levels are –

We have set our levels at 1.75mg/I for Chlorine and 7.2 for the pH Value.
