## How to tell a Sensory Story.

In class we would tell this story using a range of different sounds, actions and props.

In this way we hope to engage the children's attention and help them link a specific action with each part of the story.

This helps them to anticipate events in the story.


We would gradually increase their understanding by repeating the story many times over the weeks.

If you would like to give this a go, I have suggested some actions you can do to/with your child as you read the story.


Add in actions that you know your child enjoys and will look forward to.


Read each story page and then engage your child with the action.


Don't worry to much if they don't appear to be listening or reacting - keep going through the story. It might take quite a few readings for them to become familiar with the story. You might begin to see them react to and anticipate certain actions .... the water sprayer is usually a big hit in Panda class!




Tip: We keep all the items for the story handy in one box or bag. You might want to print the story out and have it in the box too.












You could use the tin and bead/button from the last page!




















Lawnmower Sound Effect, Lawnmower White Noise, 12 Hours







Press your both your hands onto your child's shoulders, arms or knees each time you say 'waited'. (As much pressure as you know your child enjoys.)




Trickle sand or soil over your hand or onto your child's hand.









Or make this BSL sign for 'sad'.
