Additional Needs Pathway Advisers

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14-25 Additional Needs Team

Working with young people aged 14-25, who have or had a Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP), and who attend or have attended specialist provision both within and outside the county.



Who is in the team

The team consists of:

- Additional Needs Pathway Advisers
- Additional Needs Pathway Coordinator

What we do

The 14 – 25 Additional Needs Team provides early targeted support to young people who are attending or have attended specialist provision both within and outside the county and who have or have had an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) or Statement of Special Educational Needs in order to ensure they make a smooth transition when moving from school to Further Education, Employment or Training. They also work with young people who are not in education, employment or training (NEET).

Additional Needs Pathway Adviser

The Pathway Advisers provide information, advice and guidance on education, training, employment and other appropriate options for young people with special educational needs and disabilities and their families. They provide a vital role in supporting young people to consider options for when your child moves on from school or college.

Additional Needs Pathway Coordinator

The Pathway Coordinator provides specialist early targeted support to young people who are, or are at risk of, becoming NEET. She can provide impartial advice and guidance and look at possible options with you and your child and can help with college applications, arranging visits to colleges or training providers and taster sessions.

How to access our service

Young people are often referred by their school or college.

Parents/Carers can contact the team direct as can other professionals.

Young people can also self-refer.
