# **Highlights this month**

We have already had several 6<sup>th</sup> form residential experiences since my last newsletter and this week our silver group undertake their assessed expedition; very good luck to you all.

It has been a busy term in sport, with lots of inter school competitions taking place some at regional level. Just before half term a KS5 team of students represented Granta and Cambridgeshire in the Regional Table Cricket competition at Newmarket. The team had previously qualified by winning the Cambridgeshire competition. The team played incredibly well narrowly missing out on a place in the final, coming 3<sup>rd</sup>. Some KS3 students participated in the South Cambs Outdoor Athletics Competition at Wilberforce Road, Cambridge on Thursday 13 June. In very wet and cold conditions the students were a credit to the school. Some KS2 students are representing school on Tuesday 18 June again at Wilberforce Road, Cambridge with many of the mainstream primary schools in South Cambridgeshire. KS4 and 5 students travelled across the county to the St Neot's Football Academy earlier in June to play in the Cambridgeshire Special Schools Tournament and showed improved tactics and teamwork as the tournament progressed. Back at the beginning of term, Granta hosted the Cambridgeshire Special Schools Rounders Tournament. KS4 represented the school on this occasion and worked in partnership with students from other schools in skills practices before playing competitively against each other.
