Don't worry if you can't match a word to each character- some will be easier to describe than others. Remember how we used the synonym tool on word to find new describing words?

d) Write 2 -3 sentences predicting what you think will happen in the next episode. I have set up a Purple Mash "2Do" template for this if you want to use it.
