

In 2025, the Student Council was closely involved in decision-making around school meals. Pupils worked alongside staff to help improve meal options, ensuring they are accessible to all pupils while offering a variety of healthy, nutritious, and enjoyable choices. This remains an ongoing project, with Student Council representatives continuing to provide feedback and suggestions for further development.

The Student Council has also played a vital role in promoting reading and reading for pleasure across Granta School. Pupils have worked hard to develop outdoor reading areas, a project that will be completed this year with pupils taking an active role in designing, decorating, and constructing these spaces. In addition, pupils reviewed the school library, offering feedback on books and equipment, helping to ensure the library remains a warm, welcoming environment for all. This year, the Student Council will also host an online Scholastic Book Fair to promote reading for pleasure and raise funds to purchase additional books for our library.

Each year, the Student Council leads fundraising efforts for Children in Need and Red Nose Day, organising inclusive and enjoyable school-wide activities that support these important causes.

Following a successful year redefining the role of the Student Council and strengthening teamwork and class representation, we introduced the role of Adult Mentors. These mentors provide guidance and support and act as a first point of contact for Student Council representatives as they work on their allocated projects.

This year, we are further strengthening our links with the local community. After considering several options and taking part in a pupil vote, the school has chosen to build strong partnerships with our local churches. This collaboration will involve fundraising and community support, as well as welcoming church representatives into our school to develop meaningful connections.

Finally, our key project for this year focuses on the development of the school website, with pupils taking an active role in shaping and improving this important platform.
